

Missionary Evaluation of Our Church

A Tool for Missions Leadership Teams

Choose the most pertinent of these questions to better understand your missionaries' perspective on your partnership with them. This discussion is best engaged face-to-face. That way you can set a tone that encourages your workers to be frank. Your goal is to learn together how to improve your relationship. Even if their answers are painful, don't be defensive. Open communication will improve your partnership!

1. **Quality and quantity of information coming from the church.** How well do we keep you up to date on what is happening here? How could we communicate with you better?
2. **Personal connection.** Do you feel you have a strong relationship with at least several individuals and/or small groups within the church?
3. **Contribution of short-term teams.** If we have sent teams to work with you, how would you rate our preparation of them and the value of their contribution to your ministry?
4. **Quality of on-field care.** How well did we provide care for you while we were on the field? How could we improve?
5. **Quality of home-assignment care.** How well did we help you to transition to home assignment and serve you while you were here? In what areas could we improve?
6. **Financial support.** Did you receive our financial support in a timely manner? Did we respond to other financial needs?
7. **Mission leadership team personal connections.** How hard do you think our team works to know you as individuals and as a family? How could we improve?
8. **Ministry awareness.** Do you think our missions leadership team really understands your ministry? What could we do to become better informed?
9. **Information and expectations.** How clearly do we communicate to you our priorities and our expectations of you? Are you clear about how you can contact us with questions or needs?
