

Interview Questions for Your Global Workers

Before your interview, ask your missionaries to choose three or four of these questions they would like to answer.

1. Tell us about the biggest thing that happened since we last saw you that evidenced God's power at work.
2. What is one interesting characteristic of the people you serve? How does this affect your ministry to them?
3. What has been the most enjoyable part of your ministry and why?
4. What has been the most difficult aspect of your ministry and why?
5. What do you find people most often misunderstand about your ministry or those you are seeking to reach?
6. If one of the Christians in *[the country where you work]* were standing alongside you today, what would they want to say to us?
7. How would you respond to the person who says, "Becoming a missionary is throwing your life away in some remote place"?
8. There are needs everywhere, including lots of them here at home. How did you decide God wanted you in *[name of country or city where you serve]*?
9. If someone could go for a week, a month, or six months and do a particular thing that would really help you, what would it be? Is there a skill or service that someone in our congregation might use to help you and your ministry?
10. What is a God-sized need we could be praying about with you?
