

Sample Questions for a Moment-for-Missions Interview of Someone Who Has Hosted Missionaries

1. Tell us about the first time you hosted missionaries. What preconceived fears or apprehensions did you have? What was the real experience like?
2. People often say, “But I wouldn’t know what to talk to missionaries about!” How would you respond to that?
3. For a parent with children living at home: How has hosting missionaries impacted your kids? How did you prepare them in advance to be part of the hosting process?
4. What advice would you have for someone who feels like their home isn’t nice enough? Or they are afraid hosting missionaries would just be awkward?
5. What was the most fun experience you had, or story you heard, when you hosted missionaries in your home?

In a 3-5 minute “moment for missions,” you will have time for only brief answers to a few of these questions. Discuss with your interviewee which they would like to include.
